- the unit has two speeds in the rotating system: one to sear another for roasting.

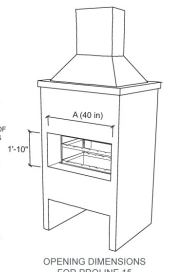
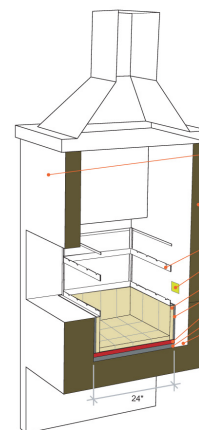
INSTALLATION OF THE EQUIPMENT

PROLINE 15 DIAGRAM OF TYPICAL INSTALLATION

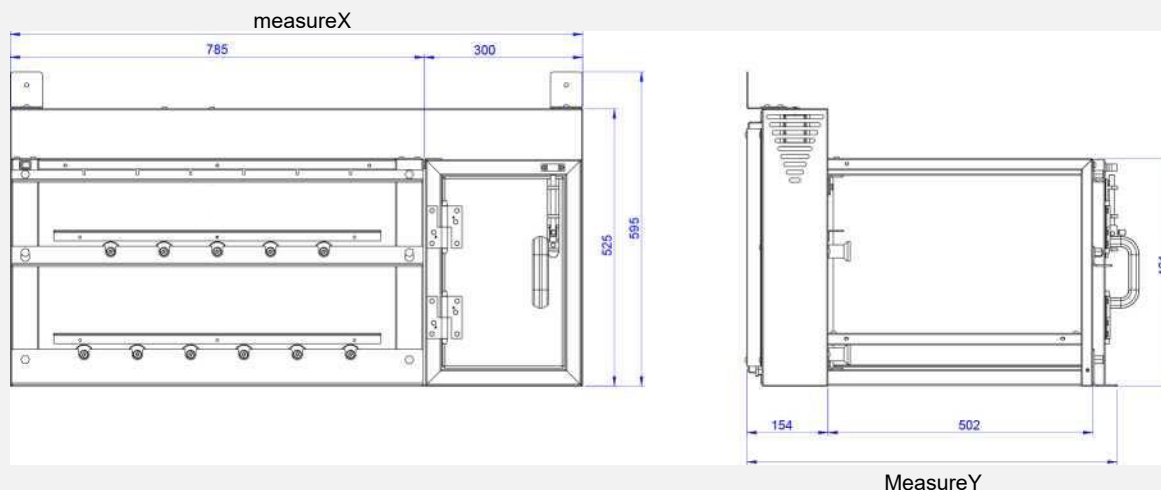

SEE DIAGRAM TO THE LEFT. AN ACCESS OPENING TO A NEAR BY ELECTRICAL OUTLET MUST BE LOCATED AT THE REAR OF THE BBQ.
